Introduction

2. Application

- Apply a thin, even coat of the release agent to the stock area where Acraglas will bond.
- Avoid overapplication to prevent excess buildup.

3. Curing

- Allow the release agent to dry completely before proceeding with the Acraglas application.
- There is no noticeable difference in dry time between the traditional and nonflammable release agents.

4. CleanUp

- Clean any spills immediately with a suitable cleaning agent.
- Dispose of any used materials in accordance with local regulations.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the product and its container in accordance with local environmental regulations.
- Do not pour the product down the drain or dispose of it in regular household waste.
