Compact & Lightweight For Easy Transport & Setup

Compact, lightweight construction for easy use. Rigid steel channels accept nominal 1" x 2" furring strips to support your target. Units are stackable to minimize storage space and decrease setup time. Approximately 18½" wide to fit all standard IPSC targets. Extra deep channels provide added target leg support. Standard model features two adjustable thumbscrews that provide a tight hold on the furring strips, and welded steel outriggers with two holes each for anchoring the stand with ground spikes. Folding model folds flat for even easier storage and transport. Drive-In model features a 10" long heavy-duty steel spike with a 2" x 2" square striking head for driving into the ground with your foot or a hammer.

IDPA/IPSC Target Stands Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the IDPA/IPSC Target Stands. This guide provides you with important safety information, usage instructions, and disposal guidelines to ensure safe and effective use of the product. Please read this manual carefully before using the target stands.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always inspect the target stand for any signs of damage or wear before use.

- **Folding Model:** Be cautious when folding and unfolding the target stand to avoid pinching fingers or causing injury.
- **DriveIn Model:** Use appropriate footwear when driving the spike into the ground. Avoid using excessive force that could lead to injury.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

Installation

1. **Unpack the Target Stand:** Remove the target stand and all components from the packaging.
2. **Inspect for Damage:** Check all parts for any visible damage or defects.
3. **Assemble the Stand:**
 - For the standard model, attach the furring strips to the rigid steel channels using the adjustable thumbscrews.
 - For the folding model, unfold the stand fully and ensure it locks into place.
 - For the drivein model, attach the spike securely to the stand.
4. **Secure the Stand:**
 - If using the ground spikes, position the stand where desired and drive the spikes into the ground to secure it.
 - Ensure that the stand is stable and does not wobble.

Usage

- Position the target stand at a safe distance from all spectators and ensure that the shooting area is clear.
- Always use appropriate safety gear, including eye and ear protection, when shooting.
- Regularly check the stability of the target stand during use, especially after multiple shots.

- After use, remove any furring strips and disassemble the stand for storage.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the target stand and any components in accordance with local waste disposal regulations.
- Recycle materials where possible, especially metal components.
- Do not dispose of the product in household waste if it can be recycled or if it contains hazardous materials.
