They also swapped out the RIS II rail system with their RIS III system, which reduces weight by using M-LOK attachment instead of picatinny. FEATURES: 14.5" chrome-lined, heavy-phosphate-coated Government profile barrel features a pinned & welded DD Flash suppressor to extend length to NFA-required 16" Fully ambidextrous lower enables shooter to operate important rifle mechanisms without moving dominant hand from rifle grip 12.5" RIS III Rail—modeled after the RIS II two-piece handguard developed for SOCOM—features M-LOK attachment for lighter weight while accommodating M203 attachment

Safety Instruction Guide for DD4 M4A1RIII

5.56MM RIFLE

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the DD4 M4A1RIII 5.56MM Rifle by Daniel Defense. This safety instruction guide is designed to ensure the safe use and handling of your firearm.
