Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Translucent Magazine for Glock® Elite Tactical Systems Group. This safety instruction guide is designed to help you use your magazine safely and effectively. Please read this guide carefully before use to ensure your safety and the safety of others.

- Ensure that the magazine is compatible with your Glock® model (17, 18, 19, 26, or 34) before use.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation:

- Make sure the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
- Align the magazine with the magazine well of your Glock® pistol.
- Push the magazine firmly into the magazine well until it clicks into place.

- Load the magazine by inserting rounds into the magazine from the top, ensuring they are seated properly.
