- When using QD swivel sockets for slings, ensure that they are securely fastened to avoid accidental detachment.
- Maintain proper grip and stance while using the shotgun to prevent accidents.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Installation

- Ensure the shotgun is completely unloaded.
- Remove the existing stock from your Remington 870 following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Align the new SHOTGUN STOCK with the receiver of the shotgun.
- Securely fasten the stock using the provided screws and tools. Ensure all screws are tightened to prevent movement during use.
- Attach the butt pad if it is not preinstalled.
- Install any desired spacer plates to adjust the length of pull if necessary.

### 2. Adjustment

- Adjust the polymer cheek piece to suit your shooting style and optics. This feature allows for a comfortable sight picture whether using iron sights, red dots, or magnified optics.
- Test the cheek piece position to ensure it maintains the same height as the factory stock when in the lowest position.

### 3. Usage

- Always check that the shotgun is unloaded before handling or adjusting the stock.

- Use the grip panels to maintain a secure hold, especially in adverse weather conditions.
- Utilize the MLOK® compatible slots for additional accessories as needed.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of the shotgun stock in accordance with local regulations regarding the disposal of firearm accessories.
