Safety Instruction Guide for AMAG 17 SG9 9MM LUGER HANDGUN MAGAZINE

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the AMAG 17 SG9 9MM Luger Handgun Magazine. This product is designed for use with the SIG Sauer P320 platform, providing reliable performance and durability. This safety instruction guide is intended to help you understand the safe use, installation, and disposal of your magazine in compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR).

General Safety Guidelines

Instructions for Installation and Usage

- Continue to load rounds until the magazine reaches its capacity of 21 rounds.
- Use a speed loader if available to make the loading process easier.

2. Inserting the Magazine into the Firearm

- Ensure that the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
- With the magazine loaded, align it with the magazine well of the firearm.
- Firmly push the magazine into the well until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction and is on safe mode.
- Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
- Grasp the magazine and pull it straight down to remove it from the firearm.

4. Cleaning and Maintenance

- Regularly clean the magazine to prevent buildup of dirt and debris.

- Remove the floorplate by pressing it down and sliding it off for thorough cleaning.
- Use a soft cloth and a mild cleaning solution to clean the magazine body and components.
- Allow all parts to dry completely before reassembling.
