CLENS LENS PROTECTION FOR FLASHLIGHTS AND WEAPON LIGHTS Lights only work well when their lenses are clean. Each CLENS Protector provides an easy way to protect lenses during extended shooting sessions. Just like goggle tear-offs for off-road riding, just remove the dirty CLENS to return your light to its optimal brightness. CLENS (pronounced "cleanse") come as a set of heat-resistant clear polymer circles, cut to fit on a wide range of flashlight and weapon-light lenses. Each CLENS Protector protects the lens from carbon and other debris that can build up during firearms training. Each CLENS Protector has a small tear-away tab. The CLENS Protector can be removed to quickly clean a light, rather than having to apply Vaseline before shooting, replace a lens, or risk abrasion with lens cleaners. Each CLENS' mild adhesive backing has a higher affinity for polymer than glass. Attach and position easily, without leaving adhesive on clean glass. However, the adhesive may stick to a dirty or damaged lens. In this case, touching the sticky side of the CLENS to any residual adhesive should remove the adhesive from the lens. - If the adhesive sticks to a dirty lens, touch the sticky side of the CLENS to any residual adhesive to help remove it.
- Do not use the CLENS Protector as a substitute for regular lens cleaning; it is intended for temporary protection during use.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation:

- Ensure that the lens of your flashlight or weapon light is clean and dry.
- Remove any existing debris or contaminants from the lens surface.

2. Application:

- Choose the appropriate size CLENS Protector from the set.
- Peel the CLENS Protector from its backing.
- Align the CLENS Protector with the lens, ensuring it covers the entire surface.
- Press gently to secure the adhesive backing to the lens.

3. Removal:

- To remove a dirty CLENS Protector, simply pull it away from the lens starting from the tearaway tab.
- Dispose of the used CLENS Protector responsibly.
