Infinitely adjustable, providing precision bullet seating depth. Bullet seating stem is machined and burnished to seat nearly any point style bullet without damage or marking. The case mouth and bullet are held in perfect alignment by a floating bullet guide. The bullet guide is provided with radial clearance to allow the case and bullet guide to align perfectly with the bullet seater screw. The floating bullet guide is reversible, simply unthread guide and re-install to allow seating and crimping simultaneously, an exclusive feature to Lee. This bullet seating die proves accuracy doesn't have to cost a lot.
