Both the JPBC-2A, JPBC-3A, JPBC-2A-6.5G, and JPBC-3A-6.5G carriers feature JP's super-hard QPQ finish for maximum wear resistance and minimal friction, while the JPBC-3SPA and JPBC-3SPA-6.5G comes in a polished stainless finish.
