These barrels are precision machined from extra-strong 4150 chrome-moly-vanadium steel alloy and have a nickel-boron coated barrel extension with M4 feed ramps to help ensure reliable feeding and extraction. The Government, M4, and SPR, and DMR profiles are all well-known among AR-15 aficionados. All barrels are chambered in 5.56 NATO, so they accept both military-type 5.56x45mm and civilian .223 Remington ammo. The DRP (Distinct Rigid Profile) is a stocky profile designed for short pistol / SBR barrels. On their longer AR-15 barrels, the Ballistic Advantage folks eliminated sharp shoulders and smoothed the tapers to symmetrically limit barrel "whip" caused by vibrations and flexing during prolonged shooting. This also controls barrel harmonics, so the barrel returns quickly to its "home" position after each shot - highly beneficial for follow up shots at a high rate of fire or even full-auto fire. Variety of lengths & contours to choose from Tough black QPQ finish All NFA rules apply to sub-16" length barrels The AR-15 platform - in rifle, pistol, carbine, or SBR form - is capable of extremely good accuracy. # Safety Instruction Guide for AR15 Modern Series Barrels 5.56mm

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Ballistic Advantage AR15 Modern Series 11.5 Carbine Barrel. This guide provides essential safety information to ensure the safe use, installation, and maintenance of your barrel. Please read this guide thoroughly before using the product.

## General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat the barrel as if it is loaded, even when it is not.
- Ensure that you are familiar with local laws and regulations regarding firearm modifications and usage.

- Attach the muzzle device (if applicable) and ensure it is properly threaded (1/228).
- Check that the gas system is properly installed and aligned.

- Conduct a function check to ensure the firearm operates correctly.
- Fire the firearm in a safe environment, adhering to all local laws and regulations.
