It flares and prepares the brass correctly so that bullets seat perfectly and won't tip over as the shellplate indexes. We have added a billet aluminum casefeed body bushing and a machined Station One Locator for enhanced reliability and longevity. The kit includes everything else you need for a complete caliber conversion.
