

Compensator Equalizer for PCC 9 mm (M14 x 1)

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The Equalizer compensator and muzzle brake was designed from the ground up by studying the gas flow of the low-pressure 9mm pistol caliber. Its three chambers are engineered to trap as much gas as possible and divert it upward, significantly reducing felt recoil. The result is faster follow-up shots, tighter groups, and less overall movement of the firearm.



Precision-machined to tight tolerances from premium barrel steel and finished with a matte bluing, it is built like a tank and will likely outlast the barrel itself.

The radially shaped chambers feature a smooth interior with no sharp corners, allowing for optimal gas flow and effortless maintenance. The Equalizer also includes three custom-fitted scrapers specifically designed for cleaning each gas chamber. We recommend cleaning the chambers after every shooting session or after a maximum of 500 rounds—no additional chemical or mechanical cleaning is required.
